

## The Reserve Homeowners Association Pool Rules ~ Effective May, 2013

**By coming to this pool, you agree to follow all rules stated below as well as those posted in the pool area.**

**NO GLASS OF ANY KIND IS PERMITTED IN THE POOL AREA. NO LIFEGUARD IS ON DUTY - USE OF THIS FACILITY WILL BE AT YOUR OWN RISK.**

- ❖ The pool is for the use of Reserve homeowners and their guests. The homeowner must accompany guests at all times. **All residents must have their key card with them at the pool and present it when requested. Trespassers may be prosecuted.**
- ❖ Entry is permitted via pass card from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. daily. The entry system will not allow access outside of these hours. Unless the Reserve Board approves otherwise, people entering the pool's enclosed area after hours will be considered trespassing.
- ❖ The maximum number of guests allowed per household is 5 and must be accompanied by the homeowner.
- ❖ Anyone under the age of 14 **MUST** be accompanied by an adult while at the pool. Ages 14-18 may be at the pool unsupervised, but may not supervise others under age 14. Anyone 18 and over will be considered an adult for these purposes.
- ❖ Close all gates behind you, and do not let unaccompanied children or visitors into the pool area.
- ❖ Emergency phone is located on the wall near the restrooms.
- ❖ Do not block pool entry steps and ladders.
- ❖ Diving is **NOT** permitted in this pool.
- ❖ Running, pushing, wrestling, fighting, spitting, horseplay, unsafe or unruly behavior, including the use of abusive or foul language, will not be tolerated. Persons abusing this policy will be asked to leave the facility for the remainder of the day.
- ❖ Food is permitted in the pool deck area and trash must be disposed of properly. **No food or chewing gum is allowed in the pool at any time. No beverages of any kind are allowed in the swimming pool.**
- ❖ Babies and children who are not toilet trained must wear swim pants covered by a swimsuit to use the pool.
- ❖ Smoking or use of any tobacco product is not permitted in the pool area.
- ❖ Bicycles, tricycles, skateboards, roller blades, scooters, Heelies, or any such wheeled devices are not permitted in the pool area at any time.
- ❖ Except during community-sponsored events, music must be played through headphones.
- ❖ No person appearing to be intoxicated or under the influence of a controlled substance will be allowed in the pool area.
- ❖ Pool furniture is not to be removed from the pool area. **Please lower umbrellas before leaving the pool.**
- ❖ Pets are not permitted in the pool area.
- ❖ To make this a fun and safe swim season, please use common sense and respect for others.
- ❖ **AT THE FIRST SIGN OF LIGHTNING, THUNDER, OR RAIN, THE POOL WILL BE CONSIDERED CLOSED UNTIL THE THREAT OF DANGER PASSES.**
